Decision No. 84/2019.

Specifying the License Fees for Providing Telecommunications Services

Pursuant to the Telecommunications Regulatory Act issued by the Royal Decree No. 30/2002;

The Executive Regulation issued by Resolution No. 144/2008;

The Decision No. 70/2014 issuing the License Fees for Providing Telecommunications Services;

The Authority's Board of Directors approval on 12th February 2019 at its meeting No. 1/2019; and

The approval of Ministry of Finance;

Based on the exigencies of the public interest;

It is decided:

Article 1:

Licensing fees for the provision of telecommunications services shall be determined in accordance with the schedule in the annex.

Article 2:

Decision No. 70/2014 referred to shall be revoked and all that infringes this Decision or contradicts with its provisions shall stand cancelled.

Article 3:

This Decision shall be published in the Gazette and shall come into force from the date following its publication.
