Resolution No. 95/2010: Amending Class I License of the Omani Qatari Telecommunications Company (S.A.O.C) for Installation and Operation of a Fixed Public Telecommunications System

Pursuant to the Telecommunications Regulatory Act issued by the Royal Decree No. 30/2002 and;

The Royal Decree No. 34/2009 issuing Class I License of the Omani Qatari Telecommunications Company for the Installation and Operation of a Fixed Public Telecommunications System;

The Authority's Decision No 93/2010 approving the application of (TDCA/S) Company to transfer its shares in the Omani Qatari Telecommunications Company (S.A.O.C) to Qatar Telecommunications Company (Qtel),

Based on the exigencies of the public interest;

It is decided:

<u>Article 1</u>	TDCA/S Company brand Name shall be replaced by Qatar Telecommunications Company (Qtel) wherever it appears in Annex (G) of the Omani Qatari Telecommunications Company's license issued by the Royal Decree No 34/2009.
<u>Article 2</u>	The Text of Clause 1 of Annex G of the Omani Qatari Telecommunications Company's license issued by the Royal Decree No 34/2009 shall be replaced with the following text: 1. Qatar Telecommunications Company (Qtel) a company registered in the State of Qatar (under registration No.: 21183) confirms that it shall continue to own 14% of the shares of the Omani Qatari Telecommunications Company till 8 th June 2015.
<u>Article 3</u>	Clause (3) of Annex G of the Omani Qatari Telecommunications Company's license issued by the Royal Decree No 34/2009 shall be deleted.
<u>Article 4</u>	This Resolution shall be published in the Gazette and shall become operative from the date of its issuance.
