Article 2	The Text of Clause 1 of Annex G of the Omani Qatari Telecommunications Company's license issued by the Royal Decree No 34/2009 shall be replaced with the following text:
	 Qatar Telecommunications Company (Qtel) a company registered in the State of Qatar (under registration No.: 21183) confirms that it shall continue to own 14% of the shares of the Omani Qatari Telecommunications Company till 8th June 2015.
Article 3	Clause (3) of Annex G of the Omani Qatari Telecommunications Company's license issued by the Royal Decree No 34/2009 shall be deleted.
Article 4	This Resolution shall be published in the Gazette and shall become operative from the date of its issuance.
